


THEIR GRAN TOLD THEM HOW SHE NEVER WENT TO SCHOOL.

... AMBUSHED THEM IN CORRIDORS BETWEEN CLASSES...




THEY THREW DIRT IN THEIR FOOD AT LUNCHTIME ...

> DIRTY GYPOS. I'LL SHOW THEM.






BUT, IN THE WOODS, ON THEIR WAY HOME, SARAH AND HER FRIENDS WERE WAITING FOR THEM.



TILLIE AND JOE REALLY DID THEIR BEST TO STAY OUT OF TROUBLE.


















